

Fairless Landfill Operations Update

(June 2021)

 The Landfill Gas Compressor Station expansion was completed May 21st. This will allow the facility to increase the landfill gas flow from the landfill.

- The cell 9 project, which consists of 17 acres, has its' complete liner system. The team anticipates certification by the end of June.
- The new sump area for the primary liner in Cell 9 has been completed.
- At the WHC Conference Awards Presentations in June, our Landscape, Pollinator and Awareness and Community Engagement projects received highest honors for programs in wildlife habitat enhancement, pollinator protection and conservation education. These awards are very competitive and based on points scored on certification applications. The WHC Project Awards are given to the highest-scoring projects in each category.
